

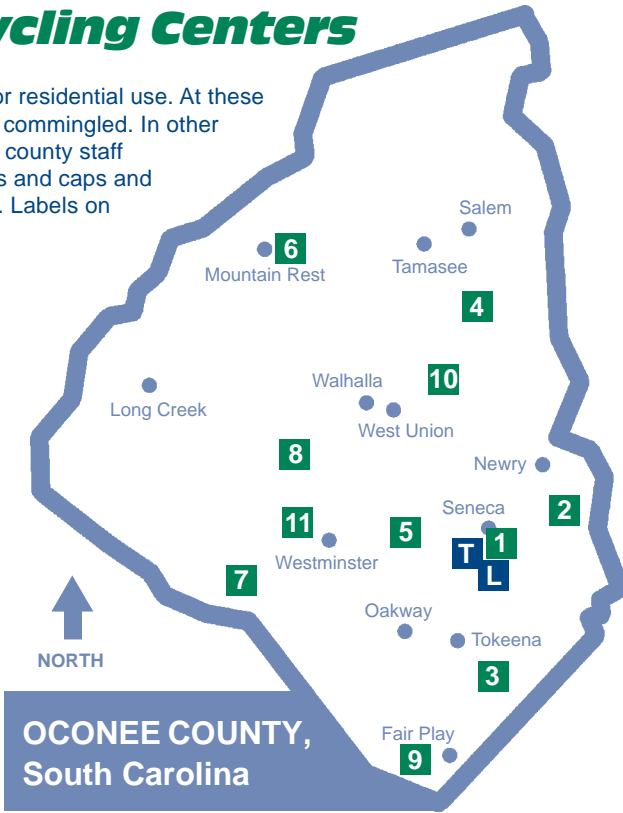
Oconee County Recycling Centers

OCONEE COUNTY RECYCLING CENTERS are for residential use. At these facilities, the method of collection for recyclables is commingled. In other words, all recyclable items are placed together and county staff separate those items. Residents should remove lids and caps and then rinse and place all recyclables in a bag or box. Labels on recyclables do not need to be removed.

Small businesses may bring recyclables to any convenience center. Industries should contact the Oconee County Solid Waste Department at **(864) 888-1440** about delivering recyclables to the Central Recycling Facility on Wells Highway.

HOURS OF OPERATION: OPEN 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.; **CLOSED** Wednesdays, Sundays and all County holidays; **OPEN** Christmas Eve and the day after the Christmas holiday.

T OCONEE COUNTY SOLID WASTE DEPARTMENT OFFICE and TRANSFER STATION – 15028 Wells Hwy., Seneca; **HOURS: OPEN** Monday – Friday, 8 a.m. – 4 p.m.; **CLOSED** for all County holidays except Christmas Eve and the day after the Christmas holiday.

L SENECA CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION DEBRIS (C&D) LANDFILL – 15028 Wells Hwy., Seneca; **HOURS: OPEN** Monday – Friday, 8 a.m. – 4 p.m. (must enter by 3:45 p.m.). **FEES:** No charge for residents; \$25 per ton for non-residential or contractor waste; cash or checks accepted.

The Seneca C&D Landfill **ACCEPTS:** building supplies (bath fixtures, rolls of carpet, block, lumber etc.); furniture and mattresses; and land-clearing debris. The Seneca C&D Landfill **DOES NOT ACCEPT:** plastics; paint or other liquids; friable asbestos; PCBs or items that have been in contact with petroleum; pesticides; preservatives; solvents; and boats.

You should know...

- **HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE** is accepted at all Oconee County Recycling Centers. Please bring needles from home health care in a sealed plastic bottle separate from your garbage. Kennel waste IS NOT accepted.
 - **PROOF OF RESIDENCE** is required for admittance to all Oconee County Solid Waste Department facilities.
 - **SMALL QUANTITIES** of construction and demolition debris (C&D) will be disposed of with household garbage in the compactor. Large loads of C&D **MUST** be taken to the C&D Landfill in Seneca.
 - **BURN BARRELS** ARE NOT accepted at Oconee County Recycling Centers.
 - **DRIED PAINT** can be placed in the garbage.
 - **USED OIL, FILTERS AND MOTOR OIL BOTTLES:** The following petroleum products **ARE ACCEPTED** and may be put into the used oil collection tank in small quantities:
 - ▶ motor oil;
 - ▶ hydraulic fluid;
 - ▶ gear oil;
 - ▶ diesel fuel;
 - ▶ fuel oil;
 - ▶ kerosene;
 - ▶ automatic transmission fluid; and
 - ▶ power steering fluid.
- The following petroleum products **ARE NOT ACCEPTED** at Oconee County Recycling Centers:
- ▶ brake fluid;
 - ▶ paint thinner/Varsol;
 - ▶ refrigeration oil; and
 - ▶ any solvent cleaner or substance used to clean paint brushes.

BATTERIES, LEAD-ACID	Used automotive, marine and lawn mower batteries	Return to a battery dealer if possible.	All Recycling Centers
BATTERIES, RECHARGEABLE	Batteries from small electronics – examples include cordless and cellular phone batteries; NO alkaline batteries	Return to a battery dealer if possible.	All Recycling Centers
CARDBOARD	Corrugated cardboard (no wax finish) including shipping boxes that have three layers of paper	Flatten.	All Recycling Centers
COOKING OIL		Transport in a plastic container with a tight-fitting lid.	All Recycling Centers
EYEGLASSES AND HEARING AIDS			All Recycling Centers
FARMER OIL	Motor oil from farm equipment	Limit 55 gallons per visit.	Central Recycling Facility and Transfer Station
GLASS FOOD CONTAINERS	Clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars are accepted; mirrors, light bulbs, Pyrex and crystal ARE NOT accepted.	Remove lids and rinse.	All Recycling Centers
NEWSPAPER AND INSERTS, MIXED PAPER AND PAPERBOARD	Dry newspapers, inserts, paper bags, magazines, junk mail, cereal-type boxes (also known as paperboard); NO paper towels or food wrappings	Keep dry. Keep newspapers separate from other papers.	All Recycling Centers
OIL/GASOLINE MIXTURE	Some additional fluids also accepted. Call (864) 888-1440 for details; NO brake fluid.		Central Recycling Facility and Transfer Station
USED MOTOR OIL, BOTTLES AND FILTERS		Transport in a tightly sealed container. Oil must be free of gasoline. Limited to five gallons per visit.	All Recycling Centers
PLASTIC	Number 1 and 2 plastic containers with a neck (look for the triangle on the bottom with a 1 or 2 inside). Examples include milk jugs, soda bottles and peanut butter jars	Remove caps and lids. Rinse. Plastic flower pots and styrofoam (although they may have a recycling symbol) are not accepted.	All Recycling Centers
PRINTER CARTRIDGES	Ink and laser cartridges from home printers		All Recycling Centers
TEXTILES	Clothing that cannot be donated	Textiles must be clean and dry.	All Recycling Centers
TIRES	Passenger vehicle tires	Limit four tires per resident. A disposal fee is charged for non-passenger tires.	All Recycling Centers and the Central Recycling Facility
YARD DEBRIS	Tree limbs, leaves, brush, Christmas trees, etc. FEES: No charge for residents; \$25 per ton for contractors	Tree limbs should be no longer than 6 feet and no more than 8 inches in diameter. Bag yard debris for transporting and remove from bags at the Transfer Station.	Central Recycling Facility and Transfer Station

Central Recycling Facility and Transfer Station

Oconee County's Solid Waste Department manages a Central Recycling Facility and Transfer Station located at 15028 Wells Highway, Seneca. It is open Monday – Friday, 8 a.m. – 4 p.m.

RECYCLABLES including scrap metal, yard waste and tires are accepted at the Central Recycling Facility.

WASTE DISPOSAL: Please pull onto the scale for instructions. Fees are payable by cash or check. Checks must be held until a total amount is calculated for multiple loads delivered on the same day. Contractors must pay \$38.50 per ton for garbage. Everyone is charged for cross ties. Please call **(864) 888-1440** before bringing fluorescent tubes, pesticides, mercury thermometers and computers.

MULCH: The Central Recycling Facility and Transfer Station also offers mulch to anyone for \$10.50 per scoop or standard pick-up load. Mulch can be purchased Wednesday through Friday from 9 a.m. – 12 p.m. and 1 p.m. – 3 p.m.
